A RESOLUTION OF KITSAP TRANSIT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING STAFF TO AUTHORIZE A CHANGE ORDER TO GILLIG, LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF INDUCTIVE CHARGING INFRASTRUCTURE

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2023, the Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 23-21 authorizing staff to purchase electric buses from Gillig, LLC utilizing the Washington State Department of Enterprise Service (DES) contract 06719; and

WHEREAS, the electric buses will be outfitted with equipment for inductive charging to support in-service on-demand charging; and

WHEREAS, to continue the electrification of the Kitsap Transit fleet charging infrastructure is necessary to support the vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Kitsap Transit staff is seeking permission to issue a change order to Gillig LLC, utilizing the Washington State DES contract; and

WHEREAS, KT issued a purchase order for 10 electric buses under resolution 23-21 / PO 12141; and

WHEREAS, this change order will add an additional sixteen (16) inductive charging units to the contract; and

WHEREAS, Kitsap Transit is seeking to install ten (10) inductive chargers at its Charleston Base in Bremerton (Phase I) and six (6) inductive chargers at Bremerton, Bainbridge, and Poulsbo Transit Centers (Phase II); and

WHEREAS, the project(s) are funded utilizing state Climate Commitment Act Funding Grant; and

WHEREAS, Gillig's proposal is fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, staff requests permission to issue change order to Gillig, LLC for equipment, support, warranty, freight, and commissioning of inductive charging equipment utilizing the Washington State DES Contract in the amount of seven million six hundred nine thousand six hundred dollars (\$7,609,600).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes staff to issue a change order to Gillig, LLC for vehicle charging equipment in the amount of seven million six hundred nine thousand six hundred dollars (\$7,609,600).
