

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-23**

A RESOLUTION OF THE KITSAP TRANSIT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING STAFF TO RENEW THE CONTRACT WITH ROCKETREZ INCLUDING MODIFICATIONS FOR THE FAST FERRY RESERVATION SYSTEM

**WHEREAS**, Kitsap Transit must use the RP1 on the Fast Ferry service between Bremerton and Seattle because of the required wake profiles; and

**WHEREAS**, the RP1 has limited passenger capacity of 118; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sailings that are at capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, during the public outreach for the Kitsap Fast Ferries, the desire for a reservation system on the Bremerton to Seattle route was strongly expressed to allow people to reserve a seat for their selected sailing; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kitsap Fast Ferry from Bremerton to Seattle currently uses a reservation system provided by RocketRez; and

**WHEREAS**, the current system has been modified to make it more useful; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kitsap Transit Board of Commissioners authorized requests for proposals for a consultant to study whether a reservation system is warranted and if so, what would best meet the customer needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the consultant recommendation is to maintain the current system and pursue additional modifications with RocketRez; and

**WHEREAS**, the RocketRez Agreement needs to be renewed in order for the reservation system to continue; and


**WHEREAS**, the cost to renew the RocketRez Agreement for one additional year with modifications is fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000);

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the Board of Commissioners hereby authorize staff to renew the RocketRez reservation system with modifications for one additional year at a cost of fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000).

**ADOPTED** by the Kitsap Transit Board of Commissioners at a regular meeting held on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2019.
