NOTE: During a recent internal audit, Kitsap Transit discovered data errors that impacted multiple tables in performance reports for previous quarters in 2024 -- specifically, tables for average daily boardings and average passengers per hour (PPH). In this report, Kitsap Transit shows corrected statistics in these tables for prior quarters. The biggest revision is to average PPH for ferries in each quarter.

The other notable revision is to average daily boardings and PPH for routed bus service in the third quarter. Using the corrected data also resulted in minor revisions to other statistics in the tables. Kitsap Transit regrets the errors and is taking steps to prevent the errors in the future.

Throughout this report, data for 2019 is presented in tables and charts to show how current trends compare to pre-pandemic.

Kitsap Transit reached an agreement with the state to fund more fast-ferry sailings on the Bremerton/Seattle route and began operating them on Dec. 1, 2022.

Kitsap Transit's passenger-only ferries carried a record 1.22 million riders in 2024, 12% more than the previous year. Ridership on Kitsap Fast Ferries, which operates three routes from the Kitsap Peninsula to downtown Seattle, grew 11% to 854,529 riders. Meanwhile, ridership on Kitsap Transit's Local Foot Ferry services, which connect Bremerton to Port Orchard and Annapolis, rose 16% to 374,336 riders. The Southworth Fast Ferry service saw the most growth – a 21% annual gain.












Systemwide Average Daily Boardings by Month – Saturdays

Average Fare Collected

Average fare is total fare revenue divided by the number of boardings. Total fare revenue consists of revenue from passes and farebox. As a result, average fares shown may be lower or higher than the one-way cash full fare. Prior to Oct. 1, 2024, Fast Ferry maximum theoretical average fare was \$6.00, assuming most passengers traveled round trip (\$12.00 divided by two trips).

NOTES: On Oct. 1, 2024, fast ferry westbound fare rose from \$10.00 to \$12.00. Due to the nature of the Kitsap Transit's On-Demand/Dial-A-Ride services, revenue is calculated between an average of Routed and *ACCESS* per trip rate. Some state agencies occasionally pay Kitsap Transit in advance for Vanpool fares. This lead to a higher average fare collected in October 2024.






